## Re: Chinese and Luner New Year - Saturday 10th \& Sunday 11th February 2024

I am writing to you regarding the plans for a large-scale event, the community celebration of the Chinese and Lunar New Year in Central London. On Saturday $10^{\text {th }}$ February, there will be a smaller, community led, day of celebrations. For this to happen, various roads in and around Chinatown will need to be closed between 11.30am and 6.00pm.

This year's main celebrations will be on Sunday $11^{\text {th }}$ February 2024, these take place in Trafalgar Square, Wardour Street, Leicester Square, Shaftesbury Avenue and Chinatown. There will be a programme of events on the Trafalgar Square stage from midday until 6.00pm. A Parade starting from Duncannon Street at 10:00 will finish in Shaftesbury Avenue where the floats will be on display for the afternoon. There will be stalls operating from 11.00am until 5.30pm in various locations.

As you will know, Chinatown gets very busy during the New Year Celebrations and therefore If you operate a business in the area, please make sure that there are no obstructions on the pavements outside or in front of your premises on either the Saturday or the Sunday events that could add to the congestion. Please do not leave any trade or private waste out on Sunday $11^{\text {th }}$ February 2024 before 6 pm .

As a result of the large number of people expected to attend on Sunday 11th and for the celebrations to take place safely, several roads will be closed to traffic. The road closures have been agreed by all agencies involved in planning the event, including Westminster City Council, Transport for London and the Metropolitan Police Service. PLEASE NOTE: Parking restrictions will be in place and vehicles will be removed if parked in suspended bays. Please look out for yellow signs informing you about parking restrictions.

Shaftesbury Avenue will be closed in both directions, between Cambridge Circus and Piccadilly Circus. It will also be closed westbound from High Holborn to Cambridge Circus. These closures will last from 8am to 8pm. Charing Cross Road will also be closed from 8 am to 8 pm , from Cambridge Circus to Trafalgar Square, in both directions. Several side roads running off Shaftesbury Avenue, Charing Cross Road and Haymarket will be fully or partially closed. Pall Mall East will be closed, and there will be limited access around Trafalgar Square.

The full list of road closures can be seen on the reverse of this letter.
Stewards will be posted in each of the affected roads so please liaise with them on the day in respect to moving any vehicle from or within the area of closure.
