As you will be aware the Government announced on Thursday 16th April that the current restriction measures will continue for at least the next three weeks.

Enforcement has always been, and remains an absolute last resort.

Our officers will continue to be out on regular patrols to keep our communities safe and to prevent crime. You will continue to see us engaging with the public and reminding them of their responsibility to stay indoors. By complying with the regulations, we are all helping to protect ourselves, our communities and the NHS.

Stay indoors; protect the NHS, save lives.
