

Operation London Bridge: Update

We have received the following information from the police regarding significant road closures in the coming days:

Wednesday 14th September (Day +5)

Her Majesty the Queen's coffin will move from Buckingham Palace to Westminster Hall at approximately 2pm.

From 5pm, Her Majesty will lie-in-state in Westminster Hall resulting in Parliament Square being closed to all vehicles. Depending on the size of queue, further spontaneous vehicular closures may occur in Victoria Embankment and Westminster Bridge Road.


At 11pm rehearsals will occur until the early hours of Thursday.

Map A - 9am until 11am - restricted vehicle access to St James's & Green Parks, Parliament Sq, Whitehall to Lambeth Bridge and St James's

To gain access, delivery drivers will need to produce:

1. Official Photo ID - Driving licence or passport
2. Delivery note or proof showing the venue and contact details for the delivery.

Staff at the road closures will then call the venue to verify the delivery.

Wednesday 14th September 2022 (Around 9am until around 11am – Restricted vehicle access)




From around 9am until around 11am, roads will be closed to all vehicles other than authorised vehicles. To gain access, delivery drivers will need to provide:

1. Official Photo ID - Driving licence or passport
2. Delivery note or proof showing the venue and contact details for the delivery.

Staff at the road closures will then call the venue to verify the delivery.

Map B - 11am to 5pm - All vehicle traffic prohibited in St James's & Green Parks, Parliament Sq, Whitehall to Lambeth Bridge and St James's

This includes pre-arranged delivery and freight vehicles. No vehicles will be admitted.

Wednesday 14th September 2022 (Around 11am until around 5pm – All vehicle access prohibited)


From around 11am until around 5pm, all vehicle traffic (including motor vehicles, motorcycles, bicycles and all other vehicles) will be expressly prohibited for all purposes. This includes pre-arranged delivery and freight vehicles. No vehicles will be admitted to the vicinity for any reason whatsoever. Please do not attempt to gain access to the area during this time as this will be refused without exception.

Map C - Approximately 5pm onwards - restricted vehicle access to St James's & Green Parks and Parliament Square environs

The existing restrictions on vehicular traffic in the St James' & Green Parks area will resume and will now include Parliament Sq and environs. To gain access, delivery drivers will need to produce:

1. Official Photo ID - Driving licence or passport
2. Delivery note or proof showing the venue and contact details for the delivery.

Staff at the road closures will then call the venue to verify the delivery.

Wednesday 14th September 2022 (Around 5pm until around 11pm – Restricted Vehicle Access)


From around 5pm until around 11pm, roads will be closed to all vehicles other than authorised vehicles. To gain access, delivery drivers will need to provide:

1. Official Photo ID - Driving licence or passport
2. Delivery note or proof showing the venue and contact details for the delivery.

Staff at the road closures will then call the venue to verify the delivery.

Map D - 11pm Wednesday to 6am Thursday - All vehicular traffic is prohibited in St James's & Green Parks, Parliament Sq, Whitehall to Lambeth Bridge and St James's

This includes pre-arranged delivery and freight vehicles. No vehicles will be admitted. There is no anticipated impact on pedestrian access throughout this time.



From around 11pm until around 6am the following day (Thursday), all vehicle traffic (including motor vehicles, motorcycles, bicycles and all other vehicles) will be expressly prohibited for all purposes. This includes pre-arranged delivery and freight vehicles. No vehicles will be admitted to the vicinity for any reason whatsoever. Please do not attempt to gain access to the area during this time as this will be refused without exception.

Look Forward

Presently planning is based upon the following expected events, however this is subject to change.

Thursday 15th (Day +6)

Until 6am, the total vehicle exclusion on Map D will remain in place. Her Majesty will lie-in-state in Westminster Hall with vehicular restrictions in the environs of Parliament Sq for the entire day. The existing restrictions on vehicular traffic in the St James' and Green Parks area will resume.
